Dear Colleagues,

Because there are several openings for new members at the EuroTAB, it might be useful to give a brief description of what the EuroTAB does:

The main and more regular duties involve reading and discussing applications for Assistant Trainer, Trainer Candidacy and Trainer status.

The latter two are discussed with the other two TABs, the AusTAB (Australia) and NATAB (North America). While doing this, we exchange our ideas and thoughts about how we read and evaluate an application. This is an ongoing and dynamic process. Additionally we discuss policies for Trainings and reflect on how we can improve them for the future.

The EuroTAB has usually one telephone conference per month and two live meetings each year. The live meetings are often accompanied by an experienced external supervisor.

The main language of the EuroTAB is English, so a good ability to speak and understand English is important. However your English doesn't have to be perfect and it is very helpful to have a variety of EuroTAB members with different languages to serve the needs of our multilingual European community!

Serving for one or two terms on the EuroTAB is an interesting valuable learning experience for everybody who wants to enter the Feldenkrais-Method on a deep professional level and wants to discuss and grow with experienced colleagues.
