Dear colleagues,

In response to the current public health emergency, EuroTAB has taken the decision to approve an option for trainees in current training programs to become authorised trainee FI teachers. Similar to the way trainees become authorised trainee ATM teachers, it would enable those trainees to provisionally give F.I lessons until they complete their final graduation. This decision parallels a similar decision by NATAB.

In the first instance, this is designed for training programs that are scheduled to graduate in 2020, which may need to postpone their final in-person training days due to the emergency situation.

Trainees enrolled in these programs will be eligible to receive authorisation from EuroTAB to offer FI lessons to the public for compensation, if the following conditions are met:

- o The trainee has completed 750 hours of the training program.
- o The trainee has successfully completed two FI lessons under supervision; these may have been completed by video, online, or live.
- o This authorisation is provisional and expires 12 months after authorisation. It is presumed that the trainee will by then have completed the training program.
- o The ED will submit plans to EuroTAB outlining means of supervision and support for these trainees.

Please note that in order to qualify for final graduation, the trainee must have completed two live (in person) FI lessons, under supervision.
